



The new Blaser S2 Safari Double Rifle

Based on the S2 line of side-by-side double rifles, Blaser introduces a specific model for Big Game hunting:

The S2 Safari offers both, the heritage of a classic safari double rifle and a bundle of innovative features that are standard for Blaser rifle design, but so far unknown amongst big bore double rifles.

The Blaser S2 Safari is built on the basic principles of a true Safari double rifle: With two barrels, two hammers and two triggers the double rifle is regarded as "the" life-insurance for hunting dangerous game.

However, accuracy has always been regarded as being the weak point behind traditional double rifles due to their design of soft-soldered barrels:

Heat-induced torque after having fired one shot and complicated regulation-processes lead to a common opinion that double rifles are only suitable for short-distance use.

The Blaser S2 Safari is the first production double-rifle ever that features free-floating barrels, being absolutely independent of the firing-sequence.

The other key-advantage and source of the S2 Safari's outstanding accuracy is the Blaser tilting block lock that prevents the lock-up

from opening- and side-bending-forces, reminiscent of the most powerful bolt-action-design.

As a sum up, the much-cited "One rifle-safari", that has been reserved for bolt-action rifles until today is now also feasible with a double rifle - the new Blaser S 2 Safari.

The new Blaser S 2 Safari comes in calibres .375 H&H Mag., .500/.416 Nitro Express (3 -"), .470 Nitro Express and .500 Nitro Express (3").

The stock-design features a straight comb with classic-style cheekpiece and Pachmayr Decelerator Recoil Pad and is therefore predestinated for shooting heavy calibres.

Barrel sets are quickly interchangeable and the Blaser

S2 Safari uses the versatile Blaser scope mount system for quick take down without any loss of zero.

Humidity, extreme climate and aggressive sweat are the typical safari conditions that cause corrosion. The special Blaser system and barrel finish serves as a highly effective rust protection.

The Blaser S 2 Safari offers outstanding balance and pointability, being critical when it comes to an instinctive shot on charging dangerous game.

Other innovative, and likewise typical Blaser features are:

- Manual cocking safety that allows the hunter to carry a loaded gun with the hammers being uncocked and therefore absolutely safe.
- Famous Blaser trigger (3 pound direct pull, crisp and clean)
- Innovative Blaser fronthanger-system allows for easy re-regulation of barrels without re-soldering and re-bluing.
- Recoil reducer in stock (tungsten powder kickstop)
- Pachmayr Decelerator recoil pad, enlarged pad-surface.
- Semi-beavertail forearm with slight Schnabel
- Straight comb with enlarged surface and classic-style cheekpiece.
- Calibres .375 H&H Mag., .500/.416 Nitro Express (3 -"), .470 Nitro Express and .500 Nitro Express (3").
- Grade levels: Standard, Luxus, Super Luxus, Exclusiv, Super Exclusiv and Royal
